Review of the CPD

Significant experience of CE marking has been gained by manufacturers, specifiers, notified bodies and enforcement authorities since CE marking has been possible. In 2006 the European Commission reviewed the Construction Products Directive (CPD) to determine its effectiveness in achieving the single market. Particular attention was given to measuring the costs/benefits to industry and the problems encountered by various stakeholders. The review provided information which the Commission will use in revising the CPD.

EGOLF / EAPFP Conference

In the light of the forthcoming revision, EGOLF (European group of organisations for fire testing, inspection and certification) and EAPFP (European Association for Passive Fire Protection) are organising a conference to be held in Luxembourg on 19th June 2007. There will be presentations from all stakeholders involved in CE marking and a **keynote presentation** from Vicente Leoz Argüelles of the European Commission on the proposals for revising the CPD.
